

John Michener Scholarship



Credit Union of America (CUA) will award scholarships to eligible high school seniors or undergraduate students, 24 years old and under, who are enrolling full time in a two or four-year college for the 2018-2019 academic school year. **Scholarships will be awarded in the amounts of \$2,000 and \$1000.**

Selection Criteria:

A Scholarship Committee made up of CUA volunteers and staff will review the applications based on the following:

- Grade point average
- Community and/or school involvement
- Essay

Eligibility Requirements:

Applicant must:

- Be the primary owner on a CUA membership share account in good standing.
- Be a high school senior graduating in 2018 or an undergraduate student, age 24 or under.
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.

How to Apply:

1. Fill in the application form fields below and type a 1-page essay. Print when complete.
2. Include the following supporting documents:
 - An official school transcript, including your cumulative GPA to date.
 - Proof of acceptance to an accredited college or university, if available. (If you have not yet received your proof of acceptance, it can be provided at the time funds are released.)
 - A photo; pictures of scholarship recipients will be used for publicity purposes only.

Deadline:

Application and supporting documents **must be received by Friday, March 30, 2018, 5:00 p.m. (CST)**. Scholarship applications will not be considered unless all required information is received by the deadline.

Awarding of Scholarships:

The Scholarship Committee will determine the winners by Friday, April 13, 2018. Winning applicants will be notified via e-mail, by Friday, April 20th.
